Veterans in our area are receiving a scam offer by U.S. Mail. The envelope indicates the offer is from the VA but it is in fact a private entity. They offer to reimburse veterans up to \$1,200 annually and provide a phone number to call.

We have reported this matter to the Fargo VA Health Administration Service, who will send it to the VA Office of Inspector General for investigation and possible further action.

Please advise your members to disregard this bogus offer and NOT call the phone number that is provided.
