Since the passage of the PACT Act in August 2022, North Dakota veterans have filed more than 3,000 toxic exposure claims and have received \$11 million. The average processing time is about five months.

Open Your Heart:

Donations: \$62,235.54

Applications: 224 for clothing. 176 attended equated to 364 children who received clothing. 48 families were no shows, that is waiting for them to call. Seven families had a second shopping day because they contact the Open Your Heart Chairman.

Food baskets: 387 baskets equating to helping 1,278 individuals and of that number 473 were children. Food vouchers were purchased rather than purchasing perishables.

All the undeliverable baskets were taken to the church and families picked up there. 4 baskets were unable to be delivered.
